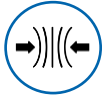

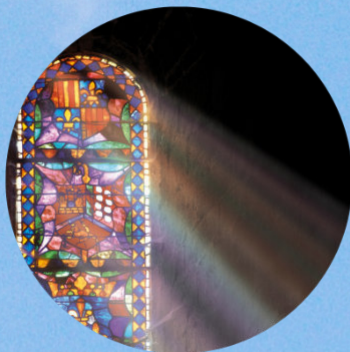
International Needs New Zealand is governed by an eight member board. Meetings are held four times per year, with an AGM held within statutory timeframes.

The international Needs Network seeks to transform lives and changes communities through the love of Jesus Christ. We express this love by addressing both the spiritual and physical needs of people and communities around the world. New Zealand's support of the work of the Network is led by International Needs New Zealand. INNZ provides administration services and oversight of the evangelical portion of the work. INNZ works alongside a second trust, INHAT, that provides the humanitarian aid and development portion of the work.

This report provides a sample of some of the amazing things God has been doing, thanks to the faithful work of the local International Needs Network members. Some of the numbers in this report are both surprising and encouraging – its hard not to get excited about a quarter of a million people hear the gospel message and 60 new churches being planted. But hidden behind the numbers is the faithful effort of 150 Christians who work in challenging conditions to make Jesus' love known. On behalf of the Board of Trustees, I'd like to thank the global team for their ceaseless work.

Here in New Zealand Shaun and the team have responded to the rapidly changing global situation with agility and determination, changing INNZ's processes and approaches. After 2 years of travel restrictions, the opening of borders gave them an opportunity to reconnect with our network partners both through a congress meeting in Canada and specific visits to key network partners. It was a joy to link with colleagues from around the world and hear and see first hand the difference they are making to the lives of some of the world's poorest people.

Financial Review

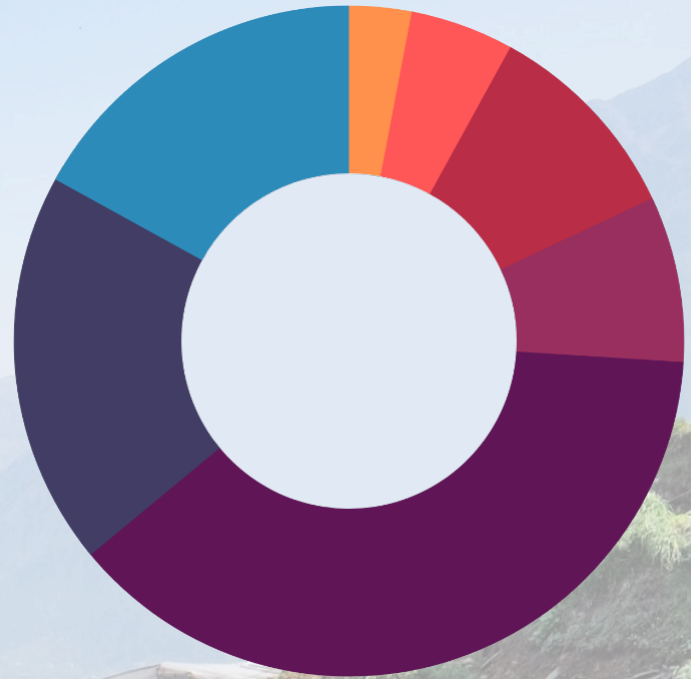
The mission of International Needs is to transform lives and change communities. We do this by inspiring everyday New Zealanders as well as church organisations, corporates, and other trust entities to partner with indigenous leaders to make a difference in their communities. During 2022, International Needs New Zealand (INNZN) supported a number of initiatives that made a difference to the lives of those less fortunate around the world, with not only practical investments, but also through sharing the Gospel of Jesus Christ, to make a long term and lasting transformation.

This included but was not limited to:

- INNZN facilitated leadership development workshops to pastors and church leaders
- Education & leadership development of local & international church pastors
- Education and advocacy on social issues and injustices around the world
- Providing support to enhance NZ church overseas mission
- Support and advocacy of religious freedom
- International support of social outreach to youth, children and women

INNZN acts on behalf of International Needs Humanitarian Aid Trust. This trust is responsible for fundraising and supporting several humanitarian and development projects across 18 countries around the world. In 2022, INNZN helped to raise over \$1.28 million dollars in support of development work such as child education and sponsorship, clean water and health initiatives, social justice advocacy, building of new wells, women's empowerment and micro finance loans, vocational skills training, support refugees and victims of natural disasters and war.

Gospel Impact Story

Gospel Crusade - Burkino Faso

It is 6.30am, a team of 10 wake early to make preparations for another full day of outreach to a rural community called Bossien, near Kongoba – Burkina Faso. After preparations, the team split up into subgroups and begin going door to door, sharing the Gospel message of Jesus Christ, handing out Bible tracts and then inviting men, women and children of the community to an evening service to hear more about Jesus.

Later that evening at about 8.30pm, over 2,000 people have come to hear what Pastor Isaiah and Pastor Jean have to say. As they share the word, many respond to the message, by coming up for prayer and to accept Jesus as their Lord and Saviour. Through this evening outreach, more 100 people gave their lives to Jesus and many testimonies were shared by others who received healing through prayer.

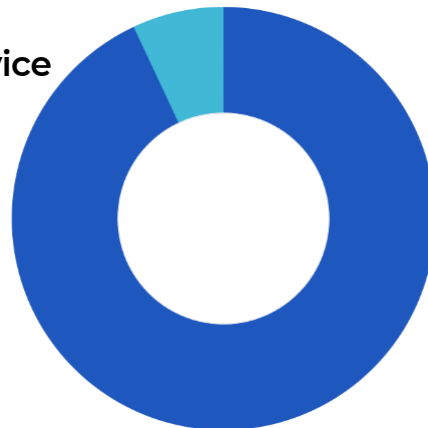
This is only one of the many outreach crusades the team in Burkina Faso are conducting before the wet season approaches. They have witnessed countless miracles at all the crusades and have seen thousands of people accept Jesus as their Lord.

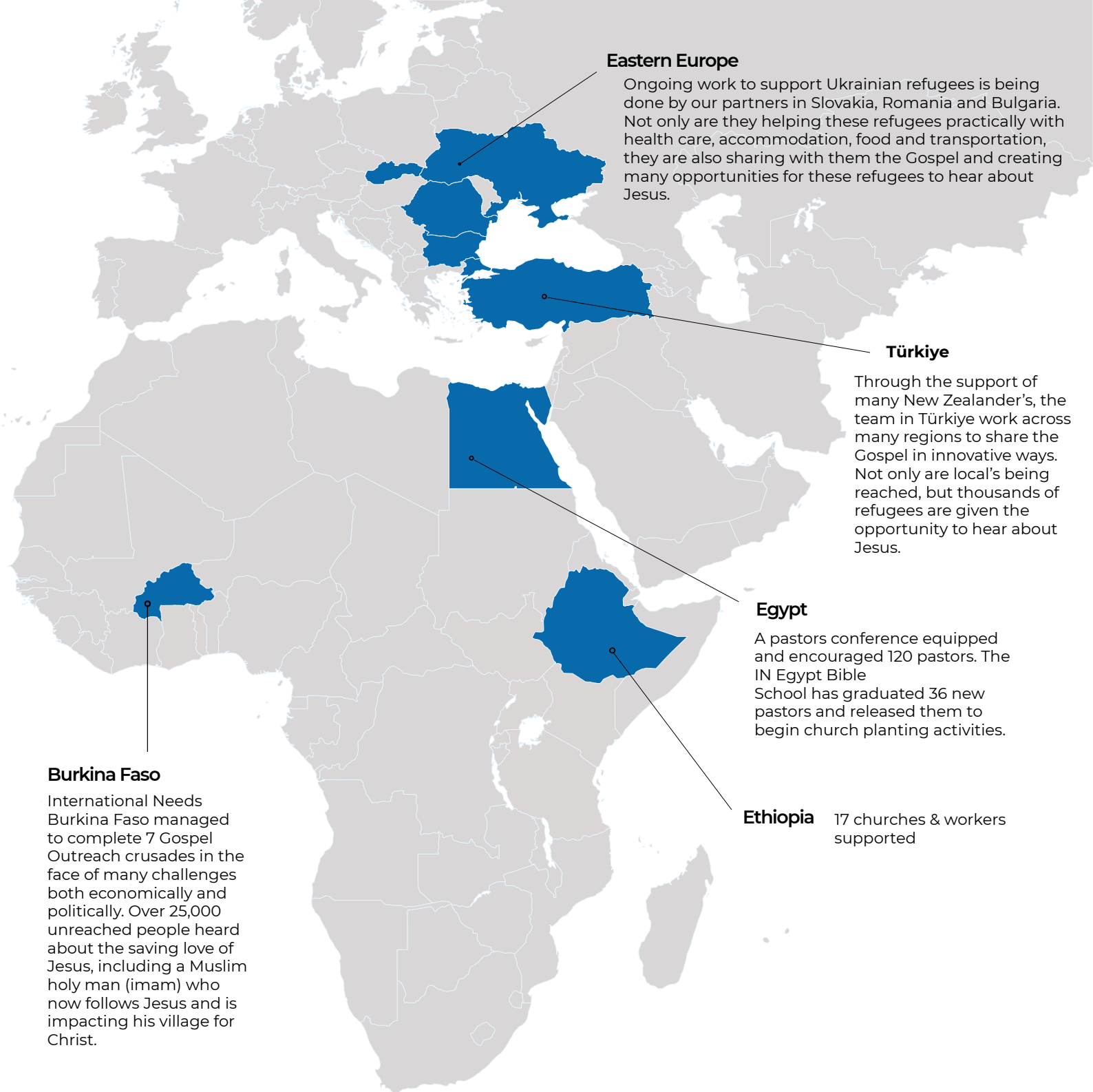

Eastern Europe

Ongoing work to support Ukrainian refugees is being done by our partners in Slovakia, Romania and Bulgaria. Not only are they helping these refugees practically with health care, accommodation, food and transportation, they are also sharing with them the Gospel and creating many opportunities for these refugees to hear about Jesus.

Türkiye

Through the support of many New Zealander's, the team in Türkiye work across many regions to share the Gospel in innovative ways. Not only are local's being reached, but thousands of refugees are given the opportunity to hear about Jesus.

Egypt

A pastors conference equipped and encouraged 120 pastors. The IN Egypt Bible School has graduated 36 new pastors and released them to begin church planting activities.

Ethiopia

17 churches & workers supported

Burkina Faso

International Needs Burkina Faso managed to complete 7 Gospel Outreach crusades in the face of many challenges both economically and politically. Over 25,000 unreached people heard about the saving love of Jesus, including a Muslim holy man (imam) who now follows Jesus and is impacting his village for Christ.

Where we work



Over 14 church workers are supported through INNZ, who cover over seven provinces of Nepal. These workers are passionate to invest into the quality of life for rural Nepalese in both physical and spiritual means. Another initiative throughout 2022, was a Bible-based Equip, Empower, and Mobilize training program, that trained 46 individuals in outreach and evangelism.

Philippines

During 2022, through supporting thirteen church planters, thousands gave their lives to Jesus. More than 97 new home fellowships were created, over 600 people were baptized and thirteen new churches have been created.

Bougainville

Through the work of Kidron Ministries, led by Sammy Marua, many youths were given the opportunity to hear the gospel message. Not only is Sammy and his team reaching their own people, Kidron ministries continue to reach tribes in the outer islands of PNG and the Solomon Islands.

Through our partners, who support the Tamang ministries and Sano Diyo, many families are being reached and impacted by God's word. Our partners work tirelessly to see the love of Jesus shared with many in rural communities and many more lives are being transformed by the message of salvation and redemption.

INNZ supports over 13 national workers across Bangladesh. These men and women work in some of the harshest conditions and reach many men, women and children in areas that have never heard of Jesus,

Here in New Zealand, INNZ played a part in sharing the wider message of international mission and the role of New Zealand church leaders to make a difference to indigenous communities. During 2022, International Needs supported a number of initiatives that inspired and educated many New Zealanders to support community outreach both locally and internationally. This included but not limited to:

Leadership development of pastors and church leaders through inter missional activities

Advocacy of social justice and education to over 2,000 New Zealanders

Ongoing support and advocacy of Waipuna Hospice charity

Education & leadership development of NZ leaders and local churches of their mission outreach

Providing support to enhance NZ church overseas mission

Impact Story: Pastor Tori Das

Meet Tori. He is a national worker serving the people of Kandra and Paikpara village near the Puthia Upazilai district in Bangladesh.

There are around 400 people that live in the village that Pastor Tori has been reaching. The people in the village suffer from many poverty-related issues, such as malnutrition, poor health, and the inability to educate their children.

Despite all the hardships, the people have been very open to hearing the Gospel message of Jesus and have given Tori the ability to speak into their lives and lead many to Christ.

In a once closed off location, many are coming to hear the life changing message of Jesus Christ through Tori.

Revenue

During the year INNZ raised more than \$2.1 million for both INNZ and International Needs Humanitarian Aid Trust

Over \$197,000 was raised for internal New Zealand purposes to help support the work of the NZ office

Motivated by Christ's love for us, we encourage everyday New Zealanders and local churches to partner with indigenous leaders to help see transformation of their people and to see the overseas indigenous church grow and thrive.

Support Sent

In the financial year of 2022, over \$1.6 million was sent to our international partners working in 19 countries. This impacted over 270,000 people through the initiatives of ministry projects, gospel outreach as well as through community development programs supported by International Needs Humanitarian Aid Trust.

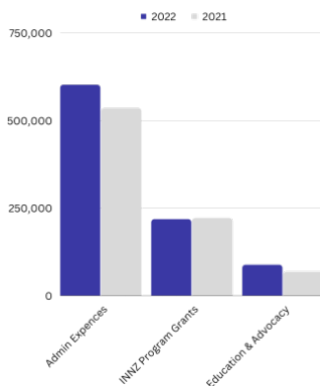
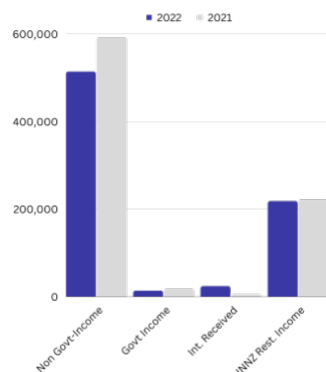
Government Support

Through the ongoing support of the New Zealand Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade, over \$43,000 was given in support of the Solo Mothers program, run by International Needs Fiji.

This amazing program helps to support single mothers from informal settlements in Suva Fiji through vocational skills training and creating a business that will see them ensure a sustainable future of their own. Along with this, their children are supported through the INFIFI day-care program. We want to thank the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade for their continued support.

The Founders Fund

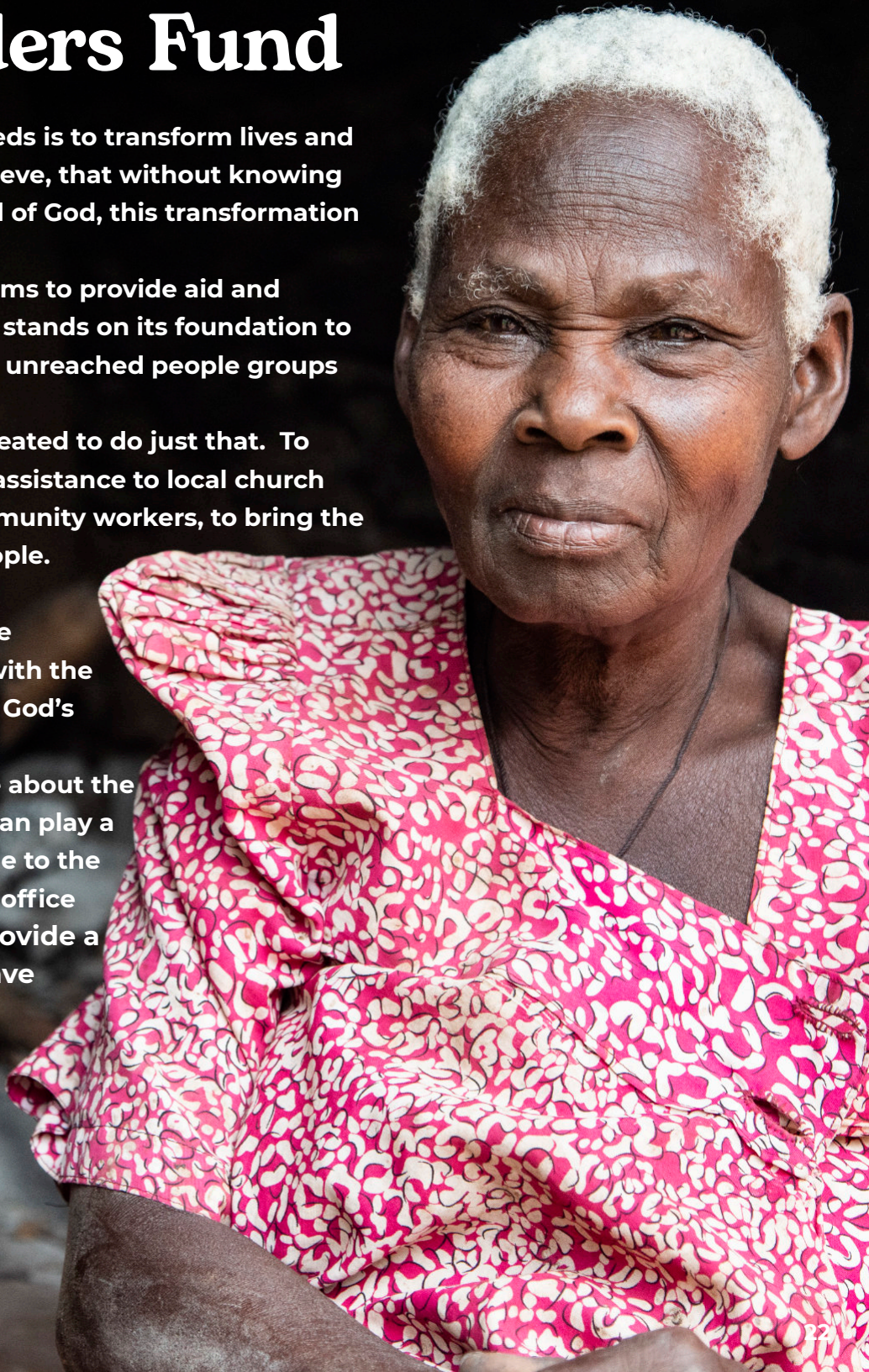
The legacy of International Needs is to transform lives and change communities. We believe, that without knowing the Gospel or hearing the word of God, this transformation is short lived.
